MES's Pillai College of Architecture, New Panvel, an Institution imparting education at the K-12, Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Doctoral levels at Pillai College of Architecture, Dr. K.M.Vasudevan Pillai Campus, Sector 16, New Panvel, Mumbai - 410206, Maharashtra, INDIA and represented by its Principal Dr. Sudnya Mahimkar and henceforth referred as PiCA as the second party

WHEREAS, both Aclude Foundation and PiCA realize their Academic potential and strengths and agree to work on a common platform to their mutual benefit.

Both the parties agree to the following terms of association and understanding.

"Start Date" means the date on which this agreement is signed by both parties.

"End Date" means the final date agreed on which the project ends as agreed to by both parties WHICH IS ONE YEAR FROM THE START DATE.

a. BACKGROUND

An access audit is one of the first of many steps that can help to improve accessibility of the built environment. Everyone should be able to fully participate within society; it is envisaged that a set of guidelines will be of interest to all those involved in access auditing/designing & building the infrastructure like building surveyors, architects, building designers, facility managers, occupational therapists, building control officers, local access groups and all those who deal with the construction and use of buildings.

It is necessary for a student in Architecture to be sensitive towards inclusive planning and train himself towards understanding the spatial needs of differently able persons. The practical knowledge of accessibility audit will definitely equip students for inclusive planning and benefit society at large.



2. SCOPE OF COOPERATION:

The Areas of cooperation will include:

This MOU will ensure co-ordination and participation of both parties for successful conduct of accessibility survey of various institutional buildings throughout Mumbai.

The above goals will be accomplished by undertaking the following activities:

1. PICA will send one Architectural student every month for ~~one~~ day duration to Aclude Foundation to facilitate and assist with accessibility awareness survey/ accessibility audit provided the student is willing to volunteer him/herself for the same.
2. The student will help in accessing and auditing the existing infrastructure of visited building and its conformance to accessibility or degree of accessibility in reference to (a)Ramps in buildings; (b)Adaptation of toilets for wheel chair users; (c)Braille symbols and auditory signals in elevators or lifts; (d) Primary health and medical care (e) availability of Sign Language Interpreters (f) Large prints or pictorial signages (g) Parking area compliance, etc.
3. Checklist Preparation and Design solution recommendation

3. EXCLUSIVITY CLAUSE

Both parties agree that their relationship is non-exclusive and that each party is free to pursue their business/academic interests with other companies/Institutes as they deem fit in their sole judgment, so long as any external business/academic relationships do not conflict with the terms and conditions of this agreement.

4. NON-COMPETE / NON HIRING CLAUSE

Both parties agree that they will not solicit, interfere with or endeavor to entice away customers, clients, partners and employees from the other party. Such clients, customers, partner or employee is defined as any company or individual which has signed a Non-Disclosure or/and a confidentiality Agreement, a Master-Services Agreement or the like, Statement of Work, or is generating revenue for the said

party. In addition, such customers, clients, employee, or partner may include any company listed in writing and tendered to the other party on a quarterly basis or specifically identified as a customer for whom Statement of Work is prepared or not. Both parties agree to abide by the Confidentiality clause with respect to such clients, customers, employee or partner. This clause shall be valid for a period of one year after the termination of the MOU.

5. FUNDING

The expenses for the survey activity to be borne by Aclude Foundation.

The other terms of this MOU shall be as under:

6. CONFIDENTIALITY:

- i. Definition. "Confidential Information" means any proprietary information, technical data, trade secrets or know-how, including, but not limited to, research, product plans, products, services, customers, customer lists, sale prospects, markets, software, developments, inventions, processes, formulas, technology, designs, drawings, engineering, hardware and software configuration information, marketing, finances or other business information disclosed by either of the parties whether in writing, orally or by drawings or inspection of parts or equipment. It also means such information belonging to the "Customers" or "Employees" of the parties hereto.
- ii. Non-Use and Non-Disclosure. Both the parties to this agreement will not, during or subsequent to the term of this Agreement, use the Confidential Information for any purpose whatsoever other than the performance of the services on behalf of the respective parties or disclose either party's Confidential Information to any third party. It is understood that said Confidential Information shall remain the sole property of the respective parties. Both the parties further agree to take all reasonable precautions to prevent any unauthorized disclosure of such Confidential Information including, but not limited to, having each employee (that covers faculty, student, affiliates) of the respective parties, if any, with access to

any Confidential Information, execute a nondisclosure agreement containing provisions in their respective favor identical to this Section of this Agreement. Confidential Information does not include information which (i) is known to either of the parties at the time of disclosure as evidenced by written records, (ii) has become publicly known and made generally available through no wrongful act of either of the parties, or (iii) has been rightfully received by either of them from a third party who is authorized to make such disclosure. Without the prior written approval of the party to whom the confidential information belongs, both the parties will not directly or indirectly disclose to anyone the existence of this Agreement or the fact that either party has this arrangement with the other.

- iii. Third Party Confidential Information. The parties recognize that they have received and in the future will receive from third parties their confidential or Proprietary information subject to a duty on either part to maintain the confidentiality of such information and to use it only for certain limited purposes. Both the parties to this agreement agree that they owe to the other and such third parties, during the term of this Agreement and thereafter, a duty to hold all such confidential or proprietary information in the strictest confidence and not to disclose it to any person, firm or corporation or to use it except as necessary in carrying out the Services consistent with the agreement with such third party.
- iv. Return of Materials. Upon the termination of this Agreement, or upon earlier request made by either of the parties to this agreement, the party to whom the request is made will deliver to the other all of the property or Confidential Information that it may have in possession or control and which belongs to the other and destroy all records thereof, electronic or otherwise, in any media or form (including on Internet or any Virtual Private Network), with it.
- v. Either Party may terminate this MOU at any time by giving written notification to the other Party on its intention to terminate this MOU, six (6) months prior to the date of the termination.


7. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF EACH PARTNER:

PICA - Rights and Obligations

- i. PiCA agrees to make it's students aware of the social activities of Aclude Foundation.
- ii. PiCA agrees to send one Architecture student every month for one day duration to Aclude Foundation to facilitate and assist with accessibility awareness survey/ accessibility audit provided the student is willing to volunteer him/herself for the same.
- iii. PiCA agrees to provide a platform to the representative of Aclude Foundation for presentation/ lecture on accessibility awareness and its application in architectural planning once in a year for which the MoU is in force.
- iv. PiCA agrees to use the information / data generated through the surveys/ projects on which PiCA student has worked, only for academic purpose and shall not claim the ownership of the same.

Aclude Foundation - Rights and Obligations

- i. Aclude Foundation shall obtain all necessary governmental registrations, permissions, etc as required for any of the survey and confirm the legality of project/ survey undertaken, they wish PiCA students to participate / volunteer in.
- ii. Aclude Foundation shall provide the necessary training and skills, including educational materials related to the project, and additional support and monitoring as needed to PiCA as well as to the student participant.
- iii. Aclude Foundation shall comply with all the local regulations in force and shall be bound by the laws of local authorities in force.
- iv. Aclude foundation shall share the information with PiCA, generated through the surveys/ projects on which the PiCA student has worked.



8. TERMS & CONDITIONS:

1. This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of PICA and Aclude Foundation. It will remain valid until the End Date, and may be continued thereafter after suitable review and agreement.
2. The parties may disclose certain confidential information to the other in relation to any future proposal made under this MoU. If applicable non-disclosure agreement will be made for each such event between the individuals involved from PICA and Aclude Foundation.
3. Each party will designate a Single Point of Contact (SPOC) for the project.
4. PICA personnel associated with this project will receive due credit proportionate to their contribution in all publications (books, conference and journal articles, technical and project reports etc) associated with the projects of Aclude Foundation.
5. Any additional Terms and Conditions subsequent to the signing of this MOU can be added as an annexure after the mutual consent of both parties.

9. USAGE OF LOGO :

- Usage of either parties Logo shall be with the prior approval of SPOCs.

10. CONJUNCTION:

This Memorandum of Agreement shall be in conjunction with Non Disclosure Agreement signed between both the parties effective 23RD JAN 2020 and both parties shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down in the said Agreement. Aclude Foundation shall continue to have the Intellectual Propriety Rights (IPRs) on the material provided by them.

11. RENEWAL, TERMINATION AND AMENDMENT:

This MOU shall be valid until the End Date, subject to further extension of time as mutually agreed. However, both the parties reserve the right to terminate this MOU during the period of validity by serving six months' notice thereof. However, both parties agree that the obligations already created under the scope of this Memorandum of understanding will survive even after such termination.

'Novelties attract us, only when they are dead and incapable of arousing vital current'

In the times we live in, the city means a lot more than what a conventional definitions/meanings that a dictionary can offer us. It has become an **idea for inhabitation** which has seen no precedent in the history for what it stands for today.

Today, a city is a model of our evolution, of a kind of complexity of various forces merging with one another for the sustainability of the either. It has become an embodiment of survival and an achieve of events, but on another level, it is also a physical laboratory, a place for experiments and a testing ground for new ideas.

Hence to initiate these experiments and to explore our future, it becomes imperative for us to **critically observe the city** for what it is and hear what it has to say.

Events related to **evolution of urbanity** and **stake holding in the physical form of the city** is an interesting dynamic one has to observe while engaging with the city. This inter-dependency is constantly influencing the urban form, especially in tier-II cities like Nashik .

Inclusion of the public realm plays a pivotal role in behavioral organization of the city .The physical-functional existence and the notional meanings of such public spaces offer the most potent catalyst for the evolution of the urban fabric.

A case of Nasik; where a river acts as a geographic/topographic separation, but simultaneously offers a wonderful socio-cultural bridge, presents the unique opportunity in the form of right and left canals to explore alternative narratives for public domain in the city.

The Gangapur dam situated to the western edge of the city of the Nashik has always been one of the primary sources of water from the days when Nasik was a small agrarian town thru the 1970 when industrial developments offered a different direction to the growth of Nashik.

The right (south) and left (north) canals were the overflow mechanisms for the dam and proved pivotal irrigation system for the agrarian community in the region. The canals were ingrained in the socio-cultural framework and physical form of the then agrarian society. These two canals, running continuous and almost parallel to river Godavari, cross the city offering a secondary spine structure to Nashik.

The development of Satpur-Ambad industrial belt exerted different developmental pressures on the area surrounding the right canal. Once a lifeline of the agrarian system, the right canal outlived its purpose shortly in the growing densities and mutating land use patterns and posed itself as a liability.

"What pleased the eyes for so many years is gone."

Urban forces, would soon invade this cultural territory, and become a repository of the out-moded and the historically superseded. And this metaphor of water, would vanish.

Over the years the stake holders of these canals change from the irrigation department to local municipality to forest department, sometimes keeping the final accountability in a grey zone.

The right canal has been reclaimed for most of its length and contains a subterranean arterial structure of pipelines where as the ground plane hosts irregular patches of green public spaces, empty land parcels, vehicular roads and wherever ownership is not stated; informal/illegal housing has consumed the most part of it.

This can be observed as a crucial event in the life of a city. Potentially, it has long lasting implications by means of offering multiple opportunities for its integration into deeper tissue of the urban settlement.

The physical continuity of this reclaimed land in public domain, running through the city presents a unique opportunity to re-interpret the existing narrative (socio-cultural and economic) of once relevant irrigation canals and to investigate the role this continuous stretch of public land can play in exploring future identities for Nashik.

This studio aims at identifying different urban design strategies for the city to 'claim' this reclaimed land in the public domain and utilize their inherent characters for the seamless engagement of the society and the infrastructure in Nashik. Also it will be important to treat this enquiry as a testing ground for these strategies to be demonstrated in the form of design proposals at macro and micro scales at crucial nodes/stretchches.

5 such nodes/stretchches are identified which offer diversity in the form of socio-cultural context, immediate economic dynamic, land use, edge conditions, infrastructural framework, demographic data and potential for future growth.

Stage 1: To observe, analyze and document the length of right canal from the west to east edge of the city

Stage 2: To propose a grand vision for the integration of this reclaimed land into physical and notional future of the city.

Stage 3: To demonstrate in detail the bespoke manifestation of the grand vision onto identified nodes/stretchches in order to create larger identity.

Node 1: canal Road- Off pipeline road.

Node 2: Krushinagar to Emerald Park

Node 3: Emerald Park to Nasardi crossing

Node 4: Indira nagar Highway underpass

Node : Wadala Road Junction near Ashoka Hospital
