



The event concluded with a vote of thanks from Prof. Kavita Sawant.





Paromita has made a number of landmark documentary films that have been shown world wide. In 2012 Time Out listed her as one of 10 people to change how Indians watch films.

About the movie:

Q2P, a film by <u>Paromita Vohra</u>, is about toilets and the city. It sifts through the dream of Mumbai as a future Shanghai and searches for public toilets, watching who has to queue to pee. As the film observes who has access to toilets and who doesn't, we hear the silence that surrounds the toilet and sense how similar it is to the silence that surrounds inequality.



The day was celebrated with spreading awareness to people by encouraging them to donate masks to people who really are in need. That is the people on the road, the poor or the servants.


The awareness was spread to people from the college first where they were asked to donate masks to the basic start from the servants and the househelp. The start can be from anywhere, the only thing important is to start.

There were many inspiring quotes told and the trial was made for people to get inspired and get the ones around them.







The Indian Ministry of Health launched the <u>Anemia</u> Mukta Bharat Program in 2018 to reduce <u>anemia</u> in vulnerable groups like women, children, and adolescents. Lifestyle and habits have weakened immunity, making people more susceptible to diseases. Ensuring women's health is crucial as they are often the family's primary caregivers.

Soroptimist International Bombay Chembur (SIBC) collaborated with MES Pillai College of Architecture, New Panyel, and Bharat Vikas Parishad, along with support from PiCA Women Development Cell, Anubhuti, and PiCA Senate. They organized a testing camp on 21/09/2022 from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm for female architecture students and staff. A total of 206 participants, including students, teaching staff, non-teaching staff, and housekeeping staff, attended.

Dr. Kirti Samudra (M.D. Physician and Diabetologist) and her lab technicians provided testing and prescribed medicines based on deficiencies. They identified three extreme cases with very low hemoglobin levels and provided them with necessary medication. Nine severe cases with high random blood sugar levels received counseling and diet guidance. Many female staff over 35 years had low bone density and were advised to increase calcium intake and modify their diet. Overall, the camp successfully raised awareness about female health.




How was the event celebrated-







The seminar concluded by a vote of thanks after which our guest speaker was felicitated with a token of appreciation for his guidance on an important aspect in the growing technological world.




