


Alumni talks provide a platform for Alumni to showcase their work to the current batches of Pica. This year, Ar. Aishwarya Gothe, a recent graduate from our institute was invited to present her thesis work to the fifth year students. The session was arranged in the last phase of the dissertation and thus speaker was informed to focus on the segments of her thesis related to the final presentation.

Prof. Ajita welcomed Aishwarya to present her thesis. Aishwarya presented her Design Dissertation work on "Making Invisibles Visible: Reintegrating Pavement Dwellers of Mumbai". She mainly talked about formulating the entire thesis, what should be the focal points, and how to arrange drawings in panels to integrate Architectural Design Development (ARD) and Design (DD) drawings on the same sheet, offering a cohesive narrative. She further explained, how strategically placing enlarged sections alongside part views, she effectively conveyed the evolution of her design concept and its detailed execution in the final jury.

Prof. Smita Dalvi discussed Aishwarya's work and highlighted key takeaways for students. Following the presentation, students engaged in a Q&A session with Aishwarya, further enriching their understanding of her research and design process.

PiCA Thesis Forum is a lecture series where X-PiCAns present the process and outcome of their final-year Design Dissertations. It offers a platform for Design Dissertation discussions and the exchange of ideas between our students, faculty, and alumni.

The Thesis Forum for Sem 9 students provided a platform for students from the previous year's batch to present their research thesis work to the current batch. This event aimed to share valuable insights, experiences, and guidance to inspire and assist current students in their thesis endeavors. The event was planned for two days. Day 1 of the forum featured presentations from two students and day 2 from three students, each presenting unique approaches and perspectives on conducting architectural research.




Day 1 - June 21, 2023:

The event commenced at 09:00 am on the 2nd Floor Studio. Prof. Ajita Deodhar welcomed Daniyal and Swarnim and asked them to share their research journeys.

Daniyal Jaweed (2018-2023) presented his thesis on "Architecture and Identity - India Pavilion." He elaborated on the significance of exploring India's architectural identity through the lens of a pavilion. Daniyal shared his site study, case studies, and the development of the program. The students were inspired by his in-depth approach and the passion he exhibited for his subject.

Swarnim Waingankar (2018-2023) explored the "Interface between aging experience and Leisure Architecture" in her thesis. She explained her choice of topic and the methodologies she employed to address this important aspect of architectural design. Swarnim's presentation resonated with the listeners, and her insights into how to understand the users and considerations for designing spaces for them were appreciable.











Day 2 - July 12, 2023:

The second day of the PiCA Thesis Forum took place at Conclave -2, 6th floor, starting at 09:00 am. Three more alumni presenters shared their research work, providing the current batch with a diverse range of architectural themes and ideas.

Subiksha Rajagopalan (2018-2023) presented her research on "Exploring the potential of bamboo as a sustainable and flexible construction material - A case of the Warli tribal community." It primarily focused on the intersection of community, material, and construction techniques. She emphasized the importance of maintaining architectural relevance throughout the research process and conducting user studies to understand the needs and preferences of the community being served.


Angel Jaison (2018-2023) presented her thesis on "Research center for Geosciences in Peninsular India." Her research centered around building typology and its correlation with geological factors. She stressed the importance of maintaining a research journal, aligning research with personal interests, defining scope and limitations, and providing comprehensive research descriptions, including application, objectives, and an engaging mode of presentation and shared the challenges she faced and the solutions she devised during her thesis journey.

Anju Pillai (2018-2023) focused on "Reimagining the Future of Kainakary Architecture for the Ephemeral Landscapes" in her thesis. Her research was centered on site-specific, place-based studies. She discussed her extensive mapping and detailed study of the macro area of Alapurzha, highlighted her experiences and solutions to challenges encountered during site studies, and emphasized the importance of proper documentation. Anju also distinguished between macro and microsite concerns and their significance in architectural research.

The Q&A session provided an interactive platform for students to seek further clarification and insights from the presenters. Discussions included effective site study techniques, the rationale behind choosing specific materials, and the importance of knowledge sharing among peers.

In conclusion, all the alumni presenters shared their unique research processes, the challenges faced, and the lessons they learned from both successes and failures. Their willingness to be open and candid about their experiences allowed the current batch to gain valuable insights into the world of architectural research and design.

The Alumni Association Committee meeting commenced at 11.30 a.m. on 21st March 2024 in the conference room. The meeting was called to order by Dr. Sudnya Mahimkar, who welcomed all the committee members and outlined the agenda for the discussion, focusing on increasing interaction between alumni and the college.

Agenda:

Discuss ways to increase interaction between alumni and the college.

Minutes:

Principal, Dr. Sudnya Mahimkar proposed that it would be possible to conduct alumni meets for different batches, where we can call alumni from five batches together to the college, and she stated that this initiative may help to increase the association of alumni with the college. The pros and cons of this approach were discussed, with the committee agreeing to deliberate further on this idea.

Prof. Jinu Kurien suggested, that 15th of August is our foundation day and that the college should an Prise start planning activities to remember the day. He proposed organizing an academic event around this a

time, allowing alumni to attend and participate. The committee will further work on exploring the establishment of such initiatives to enhance alumni engagement.

prof. Jinu Kurien informed everyone that the Mindscape initiative, active before the pandemic, has not yet been restarted but X-PiCAns are planning to host the event in the second week of December. Looking at the need for larger academic events, it was suggested that college initiatives could be combined with Mindscape, and Pica alumni could be invited to conduct workshops.

The committee agreed on the idea to plan a capstone event each year to increase interaction between the college and alumni by inviting them to attend the event and also to conduct interactive seminars and workshops for current batches. This event will be organized annually. This can be combined with an annual exhibition to showcase PiCA students' work, open to all.

The need to revise the alumni database and conduct a new survey was discussed. The committee decided to proceed with this revision to update alumni information.

The decision regarding PGM awards was brought up, with Prof. Jinu Kurien noting that further discussions are needed. And the batch/award sponsors will revert with more information on this topic.

The committee discussed the importance of reviving links with industry professionals and activating Memorandums of Understanding (MOUs) with well-established alumni and their companies.

An alumni webpage was proposed to highlight contributions to the architecture field. Prof. Jinu Kurien suggested incorporating an alumni section into the existing college magazine rather than starting a new publication. Monthly newsletters were also considered as a way to maintain communication with alumni.

The committee agreed to plan another meeting for the next semester to continue these discussions. In the meantime, efforts will be made to gather updated alumni data.




