Duration of the MoU:



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) sets for the terms and understanding between the Akshara Centre and PiCA to facilitate participation of MES's Pillai College of Architecture in jointly creating awareness about Gender inclusion in cities.

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING executed at New Panvel, India on this the 1st March ~~Feb~~ 2024 and is valid till 28th Feb 2025 by and between:

1. Akshara Centre, Mumbai based- Nonprofit organization and resource center working for the empowerment of women and girls. represented by Dr. Nandita Shah, and henceforth referred as Akshara Centre as the first party

AND

2. MES's Pillai College of Architecture, New Panvel, an Institution imparting education at the K-12, Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Doctoral levels at Pillai College of Architecture, Dr. K.M.Vasudevan Pillai Campus, Sector 16, New Panvel, Mumbai - 410206, Maharashtra, INDIA and represented by its Principal Dr. Sudnya Mahimkar and henceforth referred as PiCA as the second party

WHEREAS, both Akshara Centre and PiCA realize their Academic potential and strengths and agree to work on a common platform to their mutual benefit.

Both the parties agree to the following terms of association and understanding.

"Start Date" means the date on which this agreement is signed by both parties.

"End Date" means the final date agreed on which the project ends as agreed to by both parties WHICH IS ONE YEAR FROM THE START DATE.

1. BACKGROUND

It is necessary for a student in Architecture to be sensitive towards gender sensitive spaces and train himself towards understanding the spatial needs of Women. The knowledge of transformative cities and gender inclusive design will definitely equip students for inclusive planning and benefit society at large.

2. SCOPE OF COOPERATION:

The Areas of cooperation will include:

This MOU will ensure co-ordination and participation of both parties for successful conduct of awareness workshops on Gender Inclusion in Cities.

The above goals will be accomplished by undertaking the following activities:

1. PICA will facilitate infrastructure needed for the conduction of the workshop.
2. The students will help in conducting audit survey for streets and subways.
3. Design solution recommendation.

3. EXCLUSIVITY CLAUSE

Both parties agree that their relationship is non-exclusive and that each party is free to pursue their business/academic interests with other companies/Institutes as they deem fit in their sole judgment, so long as any external business/academic relationships do not conflict with the terms and conditions of this agreement.

4. NON-COMPETE / NON HIRING CLAUSE

Both parties agree that they will not solicit, interfere with or endeavor to entice away customers, clients, partners and employees from the other party. Such clients, customers, partner or employee is defined as any company or individual which has signed a Non-Disclosure or/and a confidentiality Agreement, a Master-Services Agreement or the like, Statement of Work, or is generating revenue for the said party. In addition, such customers, clients, employee, or partner may include any company

listed in writing and tendered to the other party on a quarterly basis or specifically identified as a customer for whom Statement of Work is prepared or not. Both parties agree to abide by the Confidentiality clause with respect to such clients, customers, employee or partner. This clause shall be valid for a period of one year after the termination of the MOU.

5. FUNDING

The expenses for the workshop activity to be borne by Akshara Centre.

PiCA to pay for guest lecturers for the lecture session of around two hours Rs. 2500/- per lecturer to Akshara Centre for the time, effort and experience sharing that they would bring in to conduct each lecture. PiCA to pay Rs. 4000/- per day for 3 day Workshop which will be for whole day (Minimum 6 hours each day).

The other terms of this MOU shall be as under:

6. CONFIDENTIALITY:

- i. Definition. "Confidential Information" means any proprietary information, technical data, trade secrets or know-how, including, but not limited to, research, product plans, products, services, customers, customer lists, sale prospects, markets, software, developments, inventions, processes, formulas, technology, designs, drawings, engineering, hardware and software configuration information, marketing, finances or other business information disclosed by either of the parties whether in writing, orally or by drawings or inspection of parts or equipment. It also means such information belonging to the "Customers" or "Employees" of the parties hereto.
- ii. Non-Use and Non-Disclosure. Both the parties to this agreement will not, during or subsequent to the term of this Agreement, use the Confidential Information for any purpose whatsoever other than the performance of the services on behalf of the respective parties or disclose either party's Confidential Information to any third party. It is understood that said Confidential Information shall remain the sole property of the respective parties. Both the parties further agree to take all

reasonable precautions to prevent any unauthorized disclosure of such Confidential Information including, but not limited to, having each employee (that covers faculty, student, affiliates) of the respective parties, if any, with access to any Confidential Information, execute a nondisclosure agreement containing provisions in their respective favor identical to this Section of this Agreement. Confidential Information does not include information which (i) is known to either of the parties at the time of disclosure as evidenced by written records, (ii) has become publicly known and made generally available through no wrongful act of either of the parties, or (iii) has been rightfully received by either of them from a third party who is authorized to make such disclosure. Without the prior written approval of the party to whom the confidential information belongs, both the parties will not directly or indirectly disclose to anyone the existence of this Agreement or the fact that either party has this arrangement with the other.

- iii. Third Party Confidential Information. The parties recognize that they have received and, in the future, will receive from third parties their confidential or Proprietary information subject to a duty on either part to maintain the confidentiality of such information and to use it only for certain limited purposes. Both the parties to this agreement agree that they owe to the other and such third parties, during the term of this Agreement and thereafter, a duty to hold all such confidential or proprietary information in the strictest confidence and not to disclose it to any person, firm or corporation or to use it except as necessary in carrying out the Services consistent with the agreement with such third party.
- iv. Return of Materials: Upon the termination of this Agreement, or upon earlier request made by either of the parties to this agreement, the party to whom the request is made will deliver to the other all of the property or Confidential Information that it may have in possession or control and which belongs to the other and destroy all records thereof, electronic or otherwise, in any media or form (including on Internet or any Virtual Private Network), with it.

- v. Either Party may terminate this MOU at any time by giving written notification to the other Party on its intention to terminate this MOU, one month prior to the date of the termination.

7. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF EACH PARTNER:

PiCA - Rights and Obligations

- i. PiCA agrees to make its students aware of the social activities of Akshara Centre.
- ii. PiCA agrees to provide a platform to the representative of Akshara Centre for presentation/ lecture on gender sensitivity, awareness and its application in architectural planning once in a year for which the MoU is in force.
- iii. PiCA agrees to use the information / data generated through the surveys/ projects on which PiCA student has worked, only for academic purpose and shall not claim the ownership of the same.

Akshara Centre - Rights and Obligations

- i. Akshara Centre shall provide the necessary training and skills, including educational materials related to the project, and additional support and monitoring as needed to PiCA as well as to the student participant.
- ii. Akshara Centre shall comply with all the local regulations in force and shall be bound by the laws of local authorities in force.
- iii. Akshara Centre shall share the information with PiCA, generated through the surveys/ projects on which the PiCA student has worked.
- iv. Akshara Centre shall provide guest lectures, workshops and awareness programs towards gender sensitivity in design to PiCA students at least once in a year.

8. TERMS & CONDITIONS:

1. This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of PiCA and Akshara Centre. It will remain valid until the **End Date**, and may be continued thereafter after suitable review and agreement.
2. The parties may disclose certain confidential information to the other in relation to any future proposal made under this MoU. If applicable non-disclosure agreement will be made for each such event between the individuals involved from PiCA and Akshara Centre.
3. Each party will designate a Single Point of Contact (SPOC) for the project.
4. PiCA personnel associated with this project will receive due credit proportionate to their contribution in all publications (books, conference and journal articles, technical and project reports etc) associated with the projects of Akshara Centre.
5. Any additional **Terms and Conditions** subsequent to the signing of this MOU can be added as an annexure after the mutual consent of both parties.

9. USAGE OF LOGO :

Usage of either parties Logo shall be with the prior approval of SPOCs.

10. CONJUNCTION:

This Memorandum of Agreement shall be in conjunction with Non Disclosure Agreement signed between both the parties effective and both parties shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down in the said Agreement.

Acude Foundation shall continue to have the Intellectual Propriety Rights (IPRs) on the material provided by them.

11. RENEWAL, TERMINATION AND AMENDMENT:

This MOU shall be valid until the End Date, subject to further extension of time as mutually agreed. However, both the parties reserve the right to terminate this MOU during the period of validity by serving one months' notice thereof. However, both

parties agree that the obligations already created under the scope of this Memorandum of understanding will survive even after such termination.

12. LEGAL JURISDICTION:

This MOU is subject to the prevailing Indian Laws.

In the event of any portion of the agreement not being tenable / enforceable under the prevailing laws, only such portions of the agreement shall stand affected and the other portions of the agreement shall remain relevant and unaffected.

The Legal jurisdiction of the Courts shall be in Mumbai (in the state of Maharashtra), India.

Engendering Cities - driving gender inclusion for better cities workshop

Introduction:

With growing urbanisation, cities create a dichotomous and complex condition for its citizens. On one hand, it offers employment opportunities for all including women and on the other hand there are infrastructure provision deficits and challenges, especially in transportation, housing and amenities. Where does gender, women, and women's rights factor into this complex process? Among all attempts towards city planning, the aspirations of the women in a city are yet to be realised as they have largely been excluded from the project of city making. There are challenges but also great opportunities for urban transformation, inclusion and change. How will the "inclusive, safe, resilient and sustainable cities and settlements" expressed in Sustainable Development Goal 11, be fully integrated with the vision of gender equality articulated in Sustainable Development Goal 5? The workshop is an attempt to engage students to address some of the questions with the design and planning tools.

Aim & Objective:

The workshop aims to sensitise the students about the need for gender inclusive planning by using tools at the city/ regional, urban design and architectural building scale. It will concentrate on the Urban Design scale and take a sectoral approach in assessment of transport, social, governance and design of a brownfield area and to ensure safety and inclusivity in a Greenfield area. It will enable the students to know and use the tools for

preparing a gender inclusive plan through a hands-on exercise.

Methodology & process:

- The process to be followed in the workshop included:
Knowledge sharing: Experience sharing about the urgent need for gender inclusion through various research, surveys and projects carried out by Akshara Centre with a focus on the development plan process for gender amenity inclusion.
- Through design and planning: Imparting of Gender planning methods at various levels by recognising, advocating, planning, policy making, surveys, designing, retrofitting, etc.
- Using audit and analysis tools: Sharing of audit surveys devised by Akshara through case studies and applying in the local street.

Academic and professional development & expected learnings through the Workshop:

Most of the city vision documents talk about gender inclusion, equality and provisioning of amenities catering to all. There is however a gap between the document and the on-ground situation. The workshop intended to help the students to know the need for gender inclusive planning and the tools to prepare such a plan. It would guide and engage them to know the following:

- What is a gender transformative / inclusive/ sensitive city?
- What role do urban professionals play in ensuring a safe and inclusive plan?
How can professionals prepare a gender inclusive design?
